As a purposeful, church-based, theological training ministry (1 Tim 3:15), East Africa Baptist School of Theology (EABST) partners with multiple local churches and serves them in their God-given duty to raise up church leaders (2 Tim 2:2). Currently, EABST is located at Emmanuel Baptist Church on King'ara Road in Nairobi.



We do not believe academic training qualifies one for ministry, but we recognize that rigorous study and thoughtful learning under the authority of God's revealed Word will help one become a skillful servant of Christ and His Church. With this in mind, EABST provides a theological library of over 11,000 books, suitable classrooms, wireless internet access, and plenty of study space to encourage appropriate learning.


We also offer U.S. accredited programs to earn Certificates, Bachelor's Degrees, and Master's Degrees

- Consumed with doing all for His glory



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

Who We Are

EABST is a growing network of missionaries, pastors, and bible believing churches who are committed to entrusting faithful men in Nairobi and beyond with the Word of God. We believe that the entrusting of the Word is best done within the context of local churches, and therefore our philosophy and programs are outgrowths of this belief.



The mission of EABST is to glorify God by partnering with local churches to equip committed servants of Jesus Christ to make disciples of all peoples and to train other faithful servants to do likewise.

EABST fulfills its mission with robust, Christ-centered, church-based, Scripture-focused degrees that specialize in building competency in real-life

ministry skills.

EABST's program is firmly grounded in the life of the local church. It is committed to the fervent worship of God in spirit and truth, wholehearted submission to the authority of Scripture, a life of Christ-pleasing holiness, and the mission of evangelizing the world by making well-taught disciples of Jesus who will make disciples.

The faculty of EABST are experienced men of conviction and proven fruitfulness in local church ministry. EABST faculty are men who have given their lives to serving the body of Christ. They are active, or serving local churches thereby giving them and their students intimate knowledge of the biblical texts, real-world skills, and spiritual power necessary to help you become a profitable servant for Jesus Christ (1 Tim 4:6).

A Resource For Local Pastors

Since EABST is grounded in the life of the local church, it is designed to work with you to help you fulfill your biblical calling to teach everything that Christ has told us (Matt 28:20) and to entrust the things which you have heard to faithful men (2 Tim 2:2). The example of Christ and his apostles and Paul with Timothy and Titus sets a pattern of personal discipleship that EABST seeks to encourage in theological training.

EABST is committed to helping you mentor the next generation of under-shepherds for Christ's church. To that end, EABST uses a rigorous biblical curriculum that will bring students face to face with the Scriptures and intellectually challenge them to make their own personal applications from the text. We believe that some of the best learning a student can do is in the context of your local church.

Therefore, significant aspects of a degree are based directly in real ministry (e.g., serving, discipling, teaching, leading, etc.) to one's local church ensuring that the students are of great benefit to his local assembly during the learning process. EABST intentionally involves you, the local pastor, and your church in the student's training by working in direct cooperation with you while mentoring, leading, evaluating, and guiding the student.



Upon graduation, your student will have learned much serving alongside you in the very body of believers most qualified to evaluate his spiritual gifts and abilities. Rather than depriving your assembly of a talented young student by taking him out of your church for theological training, EABST will work with you to disciple and train your student right at home in your local church. Not only is this far less

expensive for the student, but your church will greatly benefit from his leadership and service.
