



Certificate of Bible (C. Bib.)

20 credits

The certificate program has been designed for people within the church family who may not be in leadership positions but who desire to gain a greater knowledge of the Scriptures, and/or they do not desire the experience provided by the Leadership Development Programme. The courses in the certificate programme give a general overview of the most important subjects for the Church and provide the foundation for individual Bible study. The student who finishes the certificate programme is encouraged to seek further training upon completion.
